## CFJL Community Representative REVIEW (Prior Meeting – July 28, 2022)

#### Community Representative & Alternate Seats:

- Elected from "5 Community Representative" seats noted in BOS Proclamation
- Provides input & gives voice to concerns raised by non-county members and/or the community;
- CFJL Membership (required);
- Gives input on agenda, based upon priority agenda topics (approved/directed by CFJL Taskforce);
- Consults with RDA and Chair on matters related to priority areas;
- Able to provide Updates to CFJL Taskforce (Agendized)
- Participates in Subcommittees or Ad Hoc committees as desired (Not required for this role, by choice);
- Serve as meeting "Chair" in the absence of designated Chair (ACBH Director/Designee);
- Selected by Vote (Majority) for remaining CFJL Taskforce Tenure (unless otherwise voted by CFJL Taskforce Membership or voluntary change).

- Funding recommendations made by CFJL to individual Departments through the CFJL and/or finance subcommittee.
- Use an Eco-Systemic Framework, that allows for discussion across intercepts and includes collaborative discussions on how recommendations align across agencies.
